

General Election

Important Information

- Classes for the 2016 Election Cycle. You are required to sign up for one class.
- Classes will start on time. If you are <u>15</u> minutes or more late, you will not be allowed into the classroom and will be asked to reschedule your training.
- Training is required by law. You must attend a training class prior to each Election in order to work on Election Day
- Open Lab sessions are OPTIONAL. However, in order to provide better service to you, please register for an open lab session.
- You must register for a class or Open Lab. Walk-ins may not be granted entry due to seating limitations.



From N. East: Head south on Capital circle NE toward Apalachee Parkway.

Turn right into the Cross Creek Shopping Center.

From N. West: Head south. Go East on Tennessee Street. Go south on Capital Circle NE toward Apalachee Parkway. Turn right into the Cross Creek Shopping Center. 2990 is at the south end of the shopping center.

From South: Head north on Capital Circle SE. After crossing Apalachee Parkway, get into the left turn lane and turn left into the Cross Creek Shopping Center. 2990 is at the south end of the shopping center.

From North: Head south on Monroe Street. Turn east on Apalachee Parkway. Turn left across from King Drive into the Cross Creek Shopping Center. 2990 is at the south end of the shopping center


