

# SIGNATURE CURE OATH FOR VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT

(For use by a voter who returns a vote-by-mail ballot with a missing or non-matching signature on their voter's certificate)

## 1. INSTRUCTIONS

Use the following checklist to complete and return this form to the Leon County Supervisor of Elections Office no later than 5 p.m. on the Monday before the election.

**Complete and sign the oath below; AND**

**Include (or bring) a copy of one of the following allowable forms of identification (ID):**

Identification that includes your name and photograph: Florida driver's license; Florida ID; United States passport; debit or credit card; military identification; student identification; retirement center identification; neighborhood association identification; public assistance identification; veteran health identification card issued by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs; a Florida license to carry a concealed weapon or firearm; or an employee identification card issued by any branch, department, agency, or entity of the Federal Government, the State, a county, or a municipality.

### OR

Identification that shows your name and current residence address: current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or government document.

**Return this completed oath and the copy of your identification document to the Supervisor of Elections no later than 5 p.m. on the Monday before the election:**

- Deliver to our office or to an Early Voting site (by you or another person)
- Mail to us using the enclosed postage paid return envelope.

## 2. VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT OATH

I requested and returned a vote-by-mail ballot and I have not and will not vote more than one ballot in this election. I understand that if I commit or attempt any fraud in connection with voting, vote a fraudulent ballot or vote more than once in an election, I may be convicted of a felony of the third degree and fined up to \$5,000 and imprisoned for up to 5 years. I understand that my failure to sign this oath means that my vote-by-mail ballot will be invalidated and the penalty for supplying false information is perjury.
