Only registered voters residing within the district are eligible to elect Supervisors for this Board.

Term begins 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday after General Election.

Once a district qualifies to have any of its Board members elected by the qualified electors of the district, the initial and all subsequent elections by the qualified electors of the district shall be held at the general election in November. If no elector qualifies for a seat to be filled in an election, a vacancy in that seat shall be declared by the Board effective on the second Tuesday following the election. Within 90 days thereafter, the Board shall appoint a qualified elector to fill the vacancy. Until such appointment, the incumbent Board member in that seat shall remain in office.

If, during the term of office, a vacancy occurs, the remaining members of the Board shall fill the vacancy by an appointment for the remainder of the unexpired term.
