CHARTER FOR LEON COUNTY, FLORIDA AS PROPOSED BY LEON COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2002-17

Shall there be a Home Rule Charter for Leon County, Florida, establishing all rights and powers of local government; authorizing the proposal and adoption of ordinances by voter initiative and referendum; preserving elected constitutional officers; providing a non-partisan Supervisor of Elections; providing for non-partisan elections of county commissioners; allowing recall of commissioners by citizen referendum; and providing a method of amendment, which shall take effect November 12, 2002?
