**Leon County Supervisor of Elections to Announce Mailing of Ballots for the
General Election**

Leon County, FL – Please join Supervisor of Elections Mark S. Earley for a brief press conference Wednesday, October 3, at 9:30 a.m. in the lobby of the Leon County Election Center located at 2990-1 Apalachee Parkway. Supervisor Earley will provide details on the delivery of Vote-By-Mail ballots and promote important election dates and tips for making voting fast, smooth, and easy.

The Supervisor will mail over 28,000 Vote-By-Mail ballots to Leon County voters on Wednesday, kicking off the 2018 General Election. The Supervisor has already mailed over 2,000 Vote-By-Mail ballots to overseas voters and members of the armed forces who are serving outside of Leon County.

It is not too late to request a Vote-By-Mail ballot. Requests can be made online at LeonVotes.org or by calling our office at (850) 606-8683. Vote-By-Mail ballots for the General Election can be requested until Wednesday, October 31, 2018.

Voters should allow up to five calendar days for return delivery of their ballot if the return days include weekends. All Vote-By-Mail ballots must be returned to the Elections Office by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day, which is Tuesday, November 6, 2018.
