Pre-Election Test for the House District 7 Special Election

Event: Canvassing Board Certifies Testing Results
Time: Wednesday, May 29th at 3:00 p.m.
Location: Leon County Election Center

Preceding every election, the Supervisor of Elections is required by Florida law to conduct pre-election testing of the voting equipment not more than 10 days prior to the beginning of Early Voting. The test is conducted at the Supervisor of Elections office and is open to the public. The purpose of the pre-election test is to ensure that the voting equipment used for tabulation will accurately examine, count, and record votes.

Upon completion of pre-election testing, the Canvassing Board shall convene to certify the accuracy of the test and the voting equipment will be reset, secured, and deployed for use.
