Special Election Called for Florida House District 7

Special Primary Election Tuesday, April 9, 2019; Special Election Tuesday, June 18, 2019

Leon County, FL – The Governor of the State of Florida has called a Special Election to fill the vacancy of the office of State Representative for Florida House District 7 and has called a Special Primary Election for selecting nominees of the recognized political parties for the election. In the event that the Special Primary Election is not needed, the date of the Special Election will be held on April 9th.

Who can vote in the Special Election? In Leon County, only those registered voters that reside in precincts **2251, 2253, 2358, 2365, or 2366** are affected, as they are voting for the member who will represent their district in the Florida House of Representatives.

The **candidate qualifying period** begins at 8:00 a.m., Wednesday, February 13th, and ends at 12 p.m., Thursday, February 14th. The **voter registration deadline** for the Special Primary Election is Monday, March 11th. Early Voting in Leon County for the Special Primary Election will be Saturday, March 30th through Saturday, April 6th.

As always, eligible voters have three ways to vote in Leon County: Vote-by-Mail, Early Voting, and on Election Day at the polls.

Voters have several options for verifying their eligibility to vote in the Special Primary Election:

- Visit www.LeonVotes.org and click the [Your Voter Info](#) button to look up your voting information online. Your eligibility is listed under the “Future Elections” section.
- Check your Voter Information Card for the 4-digit precinct number listed under your name and address on the front of the card.
