## Website Help

This page provides information on the Florida Online Voter Registration (OVR) website's optimum viewing requirements. All links when clicked open in a new tab.

### Browser "Back" Button

---

Use the buttons within the online system and not the browser "Back" button.

### Browser Support

---

The Florida OVR application works best when using Microsoft Internet Explorer (IE) 8.0 or higher, Opera 10 or higher, or the latest version of Google Chrome or Mozilla Firefox. If you are using an older version of any of these browsers, you may need to upgrade to the latest version. To upgrade your browser, go to <https://browsehappy.com/>

### Display Issues

---

Check that your browser is not in 'Compatibility View' mode.

### JavaScript

---

The OVR application requires JavaScript to be enabled in your web browser. If JavaScript is disabled, you will not be able to complete your registration using our online voter registration system. You may [download a printable registration form](#) to complete, sign, and mail or deliver to your county Supervisor of Elections.

### PDF Reader

---
